In the context of the CAME-GT network and in collaboration with EC (Dr. Pilavachi) a workshop on European gas turbine combustion research will be held at DLR-Stuttgart, Germany, on 13-14th Nov. 2003.

The First International Conference on Gas Turbine Technologies organised by the CAME-GT network on 10th and 11th July 2003 at Brussels will provide a comprehensive survey of ongoing research projects in Europe and the United States. Due to the large number of presentations, concerning Framework 5 RTD Programme and others like EPRI and US DOE HEET-AGTSR Programme, the necessary time for detailed technical discussions will be severely restricted. This gap will be closed by the CAME-GT Combustion Cluster Workshop at Stuttgart.
