- **Executive summary**
- **Overview of all results**
- **Quantified data on the project**
- **Description of each single result**
- **Quantified data on each result**

*data* required described in the TIP forms

## TIP DETAILS - PART 2

- **Description of the use and dissemination of results**
- **Quantified data from each of the partners**

*data* required described in the TIP forms



## TIP DETAILS - PART 3

- **Search for collaboration (optional), through Commission services, either individually, or as a consortium, describing future needs which could include:**
  - Further R&D,
  - Licence and manufacturing agreements,
  - Joint ventures, ...

**Will be disseminated by the EC services.**

## TIP DETAILS - PART 4

Provide an appraisal of your project on:

- **Community added value and contribution to EU policies**

(e.g: developing social and technical co-operation at international level).

- **Community social objectives**

(e.g: improving the quality of life, enhancing the environment).
